In the context of the Global Money Week 2023, the Central Bank of Cyprus organises a conference on:

"Financial Literacy and Education in Cyprus:

Challenges, Lessons from Other Countries and the Way

Forward"

Outline: The Central Bank of Cyprus is organising an international conference in the context of its coordinating role on the promotion of financial literacy in Cyprus, as provided by the National Strategy for the promotion of Financial Literacy and Education in Cyprus that was adopted by the Council of Ministers in June 2022.

The conference will be separated into a morning and an afternoon session.

The morning session will be directed to selected academia members in Cyprus and will be separated into two parts. The first part will provide evidence on financial education, personal finances and financial stability in Cyprus. The second part will provide evidence from other countries that have already in place a National Strategy on financial literacy.

The afternoon session will be open to the public and the media. The Governor of the Central Bank of Cyprus will address the public with a welcoming speech. Professor Annamaria Lusardi will then give a keynote speech, followed by a short presentation of the National Strategy by the Central Bank of Cyprus. The second part will include two panel discussions drawing on the outcomes derived from the morning session. At the end of the conference, there will be time for reception networking, during which the conference participants will have the opportunity to talk to our guest speakers.
